2019 New 4X4 Bucket Truck with a telescopic aerial device that has a working height of 120 feet. Must meet or exceed the following specifications in accordance with U.S. Department of Transportation requirements.

TO NOW READ:

2019 New Bucket Truck with a telescopic aerial device that has a working height of 120 feet. Must meet or exceed the following specifications in accordance with U.S. Department of Transportation requirements.

(b) Under Specifications, Section B. Chassis, B.1 is changed *FROM*:

4X4 Six (6) Cylinder, non-regen diesel engine, with a 250 horse power (Minimum).

TO NOW READ:

Six (6) Cylinder, diesel engine, with a 250 horse power (Minimum).

(c) Under Specifications, Section B. Chassis, B.3 is changed *FROM*:

Rear tandem axle differentials.

TO NOW READ:

Rear tandem limited slip axles with differential lock activation.

4. *REMOVE* Page 5 of 22 and *REPLACE* with 5a of 22:

(a) Under Specifications, Section H. Warranty, H.1 is changed *FROM*:

A three (3) year Bumper to Bumper Warranty, to include scheduled maintenance as recommended by manufacturer maintenance booklet including oil and filter changes. Warranty must include all updates, diagnostic and inspection cost for warranty assessment.

TO NOW READ:

A two (2) year Bumper to Bumper Warranty, to include scheduled maintenance as recommended by manufacturer maintenance booklet including oil and filter changes. Warranty must include all updates, diagnostic and inspection cost for warranty assessment.

(b) Under Specifications, Section I. Guarantees, I.1 is changed *FROM*:

Dealer shall warrant the vehicle/equipment and all auxiliary equipment conforms to the proposed specifications and be free of defects from material, workmanship and title.

TO NOW READ:

Awarded vendor shall warrant the vehicle/equipment and all auxiliary equipment conforms to the proposed specifications and be free of defects from material, workmanship and title.

INCLUSION:

1. **REMOVE** Page 6 of 22 and **REPLACE** with 6a of 22:

To include Section **J. BRAND NAMES:**

Manufacturer brands and stock/part numbers specified do not denote a preference for that make, but specify the level of quality necessary. Alternate brands found to be equal to or greater in quality to the brand specified may be accepted, however, the burden to prove equality shall rest with the bidder.

The subject specifications were drafted to allow for reasonable bid competition, however, needed to be tailored to meet the needs of the Guam Power Authority. The minimum requirements specified were established through market research of product availability and capabilities with references and recommendations from local dealerships. The specifications were based on the following makes and models, therefore, bid proposals shall meet or exceed referenced examples: Freightliner M2112; Altec AH125; Versalift Condor 130-I.

Mid Pac Far East inquiry dated 01/22/19:

QUESTION:

1. Based on the Spec as Written, we cannot provide a Unit that conforms with Guam Road Weight Laws with only TWO axles (4X4).

Please amend your Spec to read 8x6, 8x8 or All-Wheel Drive. See attached ALTEC Brochure.

ANSWER:

Kindly refer to #3 of **CHANGES** above.

Morrico Equipment LLC inquiry dated 01/24/19:

QUESTION:

1. In February 2018, at GPA's request, Morrico Equipment LLC supplied Guam Power Authority (GPA) with specifications for a Freightliner M2 112 (two wheel drive only) chassis, with a Terex TM125 (20 foot) Aerial Device. Morrico advised GPA that a 4 x 4 chassis was not available for 120 foot aerial device.

Morrico request that GPA revise the published bid specifications to remove the 4 x 4 requirement, or cancel this bid in its entirety.

Guam has two fully qualified and authorized heavy truck chassis and aerial equipment dealers who can answer GPA's specification questions. Draft bid specifications can be reviewed, approved and/or changes recommended by the respective manufacturers engineering departments in a matter of hours. This step is included in Guam Procurement Regulations and costs GPA nothing.

What it will do is save Guam taxpayers millions of dollars in endless bid amendments and improved GPA equipment delivery times by months.

Guam taxpayers demand more efficiency and accountability from their government departments. A qualified review of draft government bid specifications, before they are advertised is a simple and free step that GPA Procurement Department, has to take.

Mid Pac Far East inquiry dated 01/30/19:

QUESTION:

1. We are in receipt of Amendment No.: I. Our Manufacturers are requesting an additional week be added to the Bid Opening date. New Bid Opening date requested is February 14, 2019.

ANSWER:

Kindly refer to Amendment No.: II.

Morrico Equipment LLC inquiry dated 02/01/19:

QUESTION:

1. Invitation to Bid (page 2): "the undersigned agrees that this bid remain firm and irrevocable within one hundred twenty (120) calendar days from the date opening to supply any or all of the items which prices are quoted."

It is unreasonable for GPA to expect a vendor to hold a fixed price for 120 days with multiple factors such as freight rate increased and steel price increases for this bid.

Question #1: Morrico requests for GPA to amend the bid remain firm and irrevocable within sixty (60) calendar days from the date opening.

ANSWER:

The bid shall remain firm and irrevocable within one hundred twenty (120) calendar days from the date opening to supply any or all of the items which prices are quoted. Therefore, the Authority stands firm on this requirement.

QUESTION:

2. Warranty H.1: A three (3) year Bumper to Bumper Warranty, to include scheduled maintenance as recommended by manufacturer maintenance book including oil and filter changes. Warranty must include all updates, diagnostic and inspection cost for warranty assessment.

An export warranty for Guam is provided by US manufacturers for two (2) years only. Any request by GPA for a longer term will incur a significant price increase on this truck.

Morrico request a Two (2) year warranty term with a Three (3) year Preventative Maintenance Service requirement for this truck.

A manufacturer's warranty and a preventative maintenance service are two completely different subject matters.

A manufacturer's warranty covers the cost of defects repaired within a certain time frame.

A preventative maintenance service is in accordance with manufacturer's recommendation and performed by qualified technicians.

Question #2: Will a two (2) year warranty term and a three (3) year Preventative Maintenance Service be acceptable?

ANSWER:

Kindly refer to #4(a) of **CHANGES** above.

QUESTION:

1. **Guarantees I.1** Dealer shall warrant the vehicle/equipment and all auxiliary equipment confirms to be proposed.

Question #3: Can GPA please clarify who and what qualifies the dealer as a “dealer” in this clause? Is the “dealer” referred to in this clause, required to be on Guam and is the dealer required to be the successful vendor?

We request GPA to add a clause requiring that the successful vendor supply documentation to confirm that they are the authorized dealer on Guam for every component of this truck, for example the chassis, engine, transmission and aerial device.

ANSWER:

Kindly refer to #4(b) of **CHANGES** above.

Morrice Equipment LLC inquiry dated 02/06/19:

QUESTION:

1. **Specifications:** B. CHASSIS – B.1: 4 x 4 (6) Cylinder, non-regen diesel engine with a 250 horse power (Minimum).

Freightliner has advised that the 2004 EPA Mercedes diesel engine (non-regen) is to be discontinued in the coming months.

At this date, Freightliner cannot confirm the last order date for the Mercedes engine.

Question #1: We therefore request approval to provide an alternate bid with a regen 2019 diesel engine option, please confirm this is acceptable.

ANSWER:

All other Terms and Conditions in the bid package shall remain unchanged and in full force.


