The refresher training shall be geared towards successfully passing the Substation Maintenance Technician re-certification exam, which covers topics in their courses for Substation Maintenance I, Substation Maintenance II, and Electrical Safety for Utilities.

All invoices shall include supporting documents and must be reviewed and approved by GPA Project Manager prior to invoice submittal for charges. All invoices will be paid NET 30 days from date invoice is received at the GPA Accounting Department.


Training dates to be coordinated with the training provider upon approval of the purchase order but to be completed no later than September 30, 2017.




